#### **Highlights from the Annual HOA Meeting**

Essex conducted the annual HOA meeting November 11 at Lewis Elementary. There were over 150 people that represented our community! Below are highlights of the meeting.

- Establishing a quorum. In order to establish a quorum, we need 10% of the community which equals 341 in person or by proxy. This total includes homeowners, any land builders currently own, and land the developer owns. When there is a need to vote in an HOA meeting, Essex will make sure they bring enough proxies from the developer to reach our 10% so the meeting will be official and minutes recorded.
- Introduction of attendee's from Essex Association Management, L.P.

  - Cinnamon Low Administrative Assistant
- Review of 2014 year end financials. This information can be found on the HOA website.
- Recent Texas law states when a community gets to be 10 years old, 1/3 of the board should be elected. There will be an election in the March meeting to elect one home owner to the board of directors.
- Essex set up an Advisory committee from home owners that returned the Committee Interest Form. We have 10 members on the Advisory committee right now that will meet early December. These people are Gary Sieburg, Rebecca Wathen, Randy Miller, Valicia Bryant, Kenneth Uding, LaQuintta Wilson-Owens, Amy Johnson, Brenda Haney, Amanda Ewald and John Cavender. Here is a description of the purpose of the Advisory Committee: The Travis Ranch Advisory Board will primarily serve as liaison between the residents of Travis Ranch and the Management Company and occasionally, the Board of Directors. It will especially promote transparency with the residents in the operation of the HOA. It will function in an advisory role with the Management Company where appropriate and also with the Architectural Control Committee (ACC).
- One huge concern of many residents has been the lack of care and landscaping in the common areas. Due to recent drought the water pump has had to be moved further out in the lake in order to get the sprinkler system up and running again. This project is almost complete, and a new landscape company was recently hired in order to improve the common areas in our community.
- Another area of concern has been the condition of the streets, mainly Raines County. The streets are the responsibility of the MUD district, and has been contracted out to be repaired within the next six weeks.
