You need to be there to find out what's happening in your neighborhood and to your HOA. Travis Ranch residents need to be aware of what the HOA and its management are doing. Remember, they're spending your money. Speak Up - Express your needs and concerns - and meet your neighbors.

To have a quorum and be able to legally vote on issues before the HOA (and even to have a legal Annual Meeting) we need to have 10% of the residents (actually "Owner-Members") represented in person or by proxy. YOU SHOULD HAVE RECEIVED YOUR MEETING NOTICE FROM ESSEX MANAGEMENT - CALL THEM IF YOU DON'T HAVE IT. This letter included a proxy form to use if you cannot personally attend. Fill out the form naming another Travis Ranch Owner-Member who is coming to the meeting or you may select the person listed below.) See that they receive it well before the 25th.

We have not had a quorum in recent years: it's time we showed that Travis Ranch residents care about and support their community. We only need about 128 residents attending, that's just 10%. At the meeting all items of concern will be discussed. This includes the HOA budget, activities, committees and all items of concern. Try to be there.

An Active Resident/Owner you might designate to carry your PROXY:

The chairperson of the HOA Social Committee, Kasandra Gibbs, a Travis Ranch resident and owner has agreed to accept any proxies of owners that cannot attend this meeting. You may assign your Proxy to her on the form and mail or drop it off at her home - address shown below. You may also call or e-mail her if you wish to clarify any question or let her know your concerns. She will even pick it up, if you wish.
